UP government working on exit policy for industry

The Yogi Adityanath government is working on an exit policy for the micro, small and medium enterprise (MSME) sector.

Such a policy for sick and defunct industrial units has been pending with the state government for several years but it never saw the light of the day. UP MSME and export promotion principal secretary Rajnish Dubey said on Friday the policy was now under active consideration of the government. MSMEs have along been demanding an exit policy so that promoters of such units can dispose distressed assets or start new ventures.

In its maiden Cabinet meeting on April 5, the Adityanath dispensation had constituted a group of ministers (GoM) to draft an industrial policy. The GoM is chaired by Deputy Chief Minister Dinesh Sharma and has senior ministers Rajesh Agarwal, Satish Mahana, Gopal Das Nandi and Srikant Sharma as members. It was asked to visit progressive industrial states such as Gujarat, Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh to study the policies there and prepare a similar policy for UP, to spur industrialisation and investment.

To remove Inspector Raj, the UP government is studying the policy of Maharashtra, which entails self-certification by industrial units. The GoM is also studying the single window clearance system being followed in Telangana and Gujarat to evolve a similar system for the state, to usher in transparency and faster clearance. Besides, the government is mulling setting up private industrial estates and parks span-
