### NLC India Bids Emotional Farewell to an Iconic Power Station

The glorious journey of Thermal power station-I, which commenced in 1962, comes to an end with its retirement on 30th Sept'20. South Asia's first and only lignite-fired Thermal Power Station was set up following the discovery of lignite deposits in Neyveli. The 600MW Thermal Power Station-I, the epitome of Indo-Soviet collaboration with Nine Units, 6 Units of 50MW capacity each and 3 units of 100MW capacity each, was commissioned between 1962 and 1970 in three stages with an initial capital cost of Rs.77.81 Cr. The Unit-I was dedicated to the Nation on 5th August 1962 by Dr.S.Radhakrishnan, the then President of India. Consequent to the declaring of Commercial Operation of Unit 1 of NNTPS, the replacement plant, it was scheduled to decommission the Units of TPS I in phases from March'20 to Sept'20. Accordingly all the units of TPS-I have been decommissioned and the Last unit, the 'Unit 6' was ceremoniously retired at 16:04 Hrs. on 30th Sep'20 to complete the Decommissioning of TPS-I. As the Boilers, Turbines and Generators fall silent at the iconic TPS-I, the NLCIL management and employees bid an emotional farewell to the endearing Mother Power Plant.
